FOR STUDENTS

- ALL school campus rules apply at the Fair.
- Wear closed-toe shoes (not sandals), long pants, and dress for weather (wear layers). This is a physically active event and your clothes may get dirty.
- Use this Career Fair as an opportunity to learn about possible options for your future and to practice interacting with those who can help you along your path.
- Be courteous to presenters and exhibitors and ask questions – many of them are volunteering their time.
- Absolutely No Smoking.
- No use of phones unless authorized by your group leader.
- Stay with your group at all times.

FOR TEACHERS AND CHAPERONES

- **Please keep your students with you at all times.** The format of this event allows you and your students to adventure in small groups (1 chaperon per 10 students). This offers great flexibility to choose which activities and exhibits you want to visit, but PLEASE STAY TOGETHER AS A GROUP.
- Please encourage your students to behave respectfully at all times. When visiting the exhibits, ask students to speak with exhibitors and ask questions, especially if they would like the candy or free goodies on their tables. (Set the expectation not to take from the tables unless they have spoken to the person working that table.)
- REMEMBER to bring Oregon Tradeswomen's Signed Liability and Photo Release forms with you to the Fair.
